

## Changes to meet challenges: access, demand, and simplification

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#### Access

- Access initiatives have been a part of the GMS contract for many years now and have always focused on incentivising improvement to make it easier for patients to access services.
- At the end of March 2022, 89% of GP practices across Wales had achieved all of the access standards.
- To build on that really positive progress, we will embed the phase 1 standards into the contract from April 2023.







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#### **Demand**

- Exploring opportunities around the Secondary Care waiting times
- Additional capacity funding available to help with winter pressures.
- Continue to improve the quality and availability of data to ensure we have an accurate and robust understanding of the demands on GMS.



### **Simplification**

- The proposed new Unified Contract represents the most significant reform to the GMS contract since 2004.
- Introduction of this new streamlined contract from October next year.
- Consultation is planned for April and there will be a lot more detail provided in due course.
